Rural Recycling Program Changes

Due to regulation changes in processing co-mingled recyclables and the increased cost to recycle, plastic and glass will no longer be accepted at the rural recycling boxes (in Bovill, Deary, Genesee, Juliaetta, Kendrick, Potlatch and Troy). By removing plastic and glass from recycling stations the recycling program will become more cost effective.

Rural recycling stations will have two collection boxes (excluding Bovill); one box will be sort separated with a slot for mixed tin and aluminum cans and another slot for mixed waste paper. The second box will be for cardboard, brown bags and dry food boxes like cereal/beer. Watch for new signs, reflecting these changes. Recently boxes have been contaminated with unacceptable items. If contamination continues to be problematic, recycling collection will be relocated to Bulky Waste Sites which are only available on the scheduled Saturdays in each community. The recycling boxes are serviced as needed to save on collection cost. Please contact your City Clerk if the recycling box needs to be serviced.

Residents are encouraged to bring plastic bottles and jugs (with resin codes 1 and 2) as well as glass to Moscow Recycling's 24hr. drop-off station as an alternative to placing these recyclables in the garbage. This program seeks to provide residents, particularly avid plastic and glass recyclers, with an alternative to placing these recyclables in the curbside garbage.



Solid Waste Collection Services

For cart changes, billing questions, service problems or concerns rural residents are to contact Latah County Solid Waste at 208 883 5706 residents inside city limits contact the City Clerk. If the Clerk is unavailable, contact Latah County Solid Waste.

Collection Reminder-

Roll-carts should be placed out by 7 a.m. During extreme weather events, drivers may be called in before all garbage is collected. In this unlikely event, you will not be billed for extras the following week, on the next scheduled service day.

Fall Clean-up at Bulky Waste Sites

Rural residents are allowed two pick up loads per Saturday. If you have extremely large loads, you must use the Transfer Station on the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month for free disposal of inert items including untreated lumber, sheetrock, concrete, ceramic/porcelain, metal, tree stumps, carpeting, roofing materials, mattresses, scrap metal, etc. as well as up to four passenger tires without rims and up to two large appliances.

In October the sites will accept household trash and plastic items.

Open Specified Saturdays 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Deary: 2nd & 4th Saturdays (Line Street behind elevators)

Genesee: 2nd & 4th Saturdays (Morscheck Road)

Juliaetta: 1st & 3rd Saturdays (South on Hwy 3 past ball park)

Potlatch: 1st & 3rd Saturdays (South on Pine Street 1/4 mile to old pit)

Troy: 2nd & 4th Saturdays (3299 Highway 8 East, Moscow)

Electronic and hazardous waste is never accepted at the Bulky Waste Sites.

***Dumping at any other time is a prosecutable offense.

Dates to Remember

- **Free Shred Day**

On October 6th from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Latah County Fair Grounds (enter off White Ave.). Bring up to three grocery bags full of documents to be professionally shredded on site. Staples, small clips and folders can remain on the documents. This program is sponsored by Latah County Solid Waste, the City of Moscow's Sanitation Department and Latah Sanitation.

- **Household Hazardous Waste Facility Fall/Winter Hours Begin**

Beginning Saturday, November 3, 2018 the HHW Facility will be open on the **first Saturday** of each month. The hours of operation will be 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

- **Tree Collection:**

After the Holidays bring your tree to Moscow Recycling's 24-hour yard waste drop-off site on N. Almon Street or the Waste Transfer Station Yard Waste drop-off on Highway 8 East, open from 8 a.m. - 4 p.m. Monday - Saturday. Trees must be in 5 foot segments or smaller and free of decorations and stands.

- **Holiday Collection Schedule:**

There will be no collection on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas and New Year's Day. If your service day falls on or after the holiday, garbage collection service will be one day late with service through Saturday.
